what we offer

NMMU is one of six comprehensive universities in South Africa, offering both general and professionally oriented university programmes from the entrance level (certificate) through to research level (PhD).

Our university has a strong track record in both fundamental and applied research, working extensively in partnership with business and industry.

Our range of about 450 programmes equips students for careers in more than 130 broad fields. Programmes are internationally recognised and accredited by the relevant professional bodies. Along with a first-class academic education, NMMU provides students with a co-curricular report reflecting their involvement beyond the classroom as part of the university's quest to produce holistic, socially-just students.





We offer extended curriculum programmes to provide access for underprepared students, as well as academic support programmes and student services. We offer free Wi-Fi and are at the forefront of all technological advances in improving the acquisition of knowledge. Some of our computer laboratories are open 24/7 and our on-line libraries and teaching aids are always available to a generation that has never known a world without screens.

Financial aid packages are available to assist financially needy, academically deserving students, while top achievers are rewarded through a merit award system or the Vice-Chancellor's Scholarship, the largest bursary awarded by a public university in South Africa.

- Our diversity and multiculturalism. 8% of our students come from outside of South Africa, making NMMU a popular choice for international students. Our African students come from 34 countries on the continent.
- Our High Resolution Transmission Electron Microscopy Centre opened in 2011 with its suite of state-of-the-art microscopes enabling cutting-edge research on an international level.
- Our international award-winning choir which captured the essence of South Africa in a flash mob that has been viewed around the globe to great acclaim.
- Our win-win links with industry and businesses, particularly within the automotive, tourism and pharmaceutical industries.

- Our sportsmen and women, particularly our cricket, judo and chess teams which consistently win national student tournaments.

facilities

NMMU offers top facilities in support of its key business of teaching and learning.

Along with free Wi-Fi on all six campuses, students have access to well-equipped laboratories for specific subjects, computer laboratories (some open 24 hours), lecture halls, cafeterias, food courts and coffee shops.

NMMU's campus library and information services network offers an integrated online library system serving students and staff. Services include information literacy and database training, internet access, inter-library loans and an extensive multimedia and video collection.

Student residences are available on some campuses, along with a wide range of accommodation options available in surrounding suburbs. The university offers an accreditation and referral service for off-campus accommodation.







South Campus has a dedicated postgraduate student village, while international students have access to on-campus residences as well as university houses and private accommodation off-campus.

NMMU boasts the finest sports facilities in the Eastern Cape and among the best of any university in the country. Most campuses have sports facilities as our Madibaz compete actively at all levels. We have a proud track record of producing players for provincial and national teams in various sport codes. Summerstrand's South Campus is home to an aquatics and fitness centre.

NMMU has numerous facilities for conferences, meetings, sports events and other special events. With seating for close on 4 000, the NMMU Indoor Centre on Missionvale Campus is the largest indoor venue in the Eastern Cape.


The Association offers Alumni benefits and services which include a free NMMU application fee for themselves and their children, discounted library membership and newsletters.



Student ethnicity




Student gender
